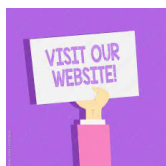

✝ PASTOR'S NOTE ✝

Dear friends in Christ!

Recently we've had a Task Force that has prayerfully looked at the direction of the ministry that the Risen Lord Jesus has given to us here at St. Timothy. While the turnout has been quite disappointing, the Task Force itself has been fruitful. We have zeroed in on several specific areas that St. Timothy can focus its attention and energy the next several years in addition to the many good ministries that are already in place.

The first potential ministry opportunity that the Task Force has identified is the simplest and least expensive to implement. Many school assignments nowadays require internet access to complete, but many families in the Lakeville area do not have reliable internet access. The Task Force proposes that we establish an "internet cafe" in the annex that would operate during school days, offering free internet access for middle and high school students (with snacks offered at cost). This idea has been presented to the church council and was subsequently adopted for the '26-'27 school year beginning this September.

So, what does this new outreach ministry need to be successful? Simply enough, it needs *you* dear friends! It needs you to volunteer to be there when it's up and running (from 2:30 – 6:00 pm on school days), not every day, but consistently. It needs you to be present; to be willing to engage with and talk to students; to build relationships with teenagers; to be available to talk and listen. Maybe offer help on homework, or just encouragement.

My brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus let me share with you the secret to church growth, to expanding the Kingdom of God: all ministry is simply relationship-building. And that is what we are hoping this internet cafe will allow us—all of us—to do: to build relationships with the people in our community; to share in their lives; to have the opportunity to share the love of God revealed in His Son's life, death and resurrection in a real and meaningful way. People don't want to *hear* us tell them that Jesus loves them: they want to see it in action.

My challenge to you is to prayerfully consider how you can get involved in our new internet cafe this fall. Maybe be willing to sacrifice a Monday afternoon or Tuesday or Thursday; or maybe only twice a month or up to twice a week. But above all be willing to be present, to pray for and pray with the students that come and ask the Holy Spirit to help you build relationships with the people of our community. Pray with confidence—it's already what the Spirit wants to do in your life.
