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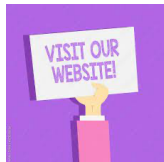

Pastor's Note:

Dear friends in Christ!

There are two seemingly different but related things on my mind as we approach September and the start of the fall season. One is discipleship: the other is our new Tim's WiFi Cafe.

Discipleship is a key part of our lives as redeemed followers of Jesus, and yet it is also the most neglected part. To be a disciple literally means to be a learner. As a baptized disciple of Jesus (covered by His blood for righteousness, called to be His follower) we spend our lives learning from Him: and we learn from Him only when we go into His Word—the Bible. So as Christians we should be involved in studying the Scriptures on a regular basis not only in personal devotions but in Bible studies as well.

Studying God's word is only half of discipleship, however: St. Paul says "[L]et our people learn to devote themselves to good works, so as to help cases of urgent need, and not be unfruitful" in Titus 3:14. As we immerse ourselves in the Good News of Jesus' love for us revealed by the Cross and empty grave, we are moved by the Holy Spirit to serve God by serving others. Our service to others—that is, our "good works"—are simply the acts of love that we do motivated by God's love revealed to us in Christ Jesus. This is discipleship in action.

This is where Tim's WiFi Cafe comes in. Volunteering to be present among those who need to use internet—whether it's for homework, work, or applying for jobs—is discipleship in action. Sacrificing part of your day just to make life easier for someone else is to (in a small way) emulate the self-sacrificial love Jesus showed us by the cross and empty grave. Showing up day after day, on a regular basis, is an important part of discipleship. That's because discipleship isn't about some big, grand gesture; it's about daily growing in love and showing love.

Dear friends I encourage you to dive into discipleship this fall, commit to growing in God's Word each day, each week. And put that discipleship into action at Tim's Cafe as we serve our LakeVille community together.

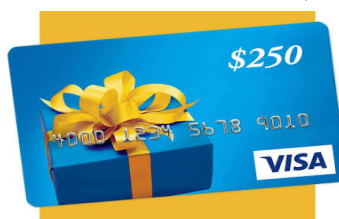
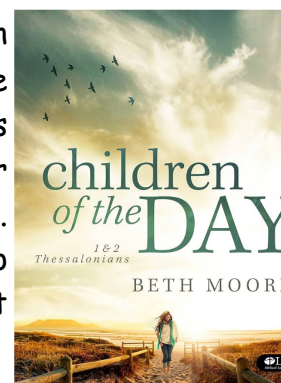

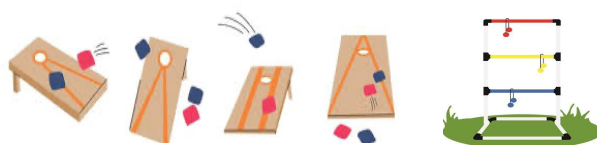
